Palm Sunday and our Christian Commitment

The common belief during the historical Jesus' ministry was that the Messiah would begin his reign by throwing the Romans out of Palestine; he'd be a military figure, riding gloriously into Jerusalem astride a horse. Such a triumphant hero wouldn't be caught dead on a donkey. By mentioning Jesus' mode of transportation, the evangelist dashed the messianic hopes of many Jews. If anyone processing into Jerusalem that day actually regarded this carpenter from Capernaum as the Messiah, he was a Messiah unlike any messiah anyone had ever dreamt about. He was giving a brand-new definition to the title.

Mark, like every author of the Christian scriptures, meant to convey that any follower of Jesus of Nazareth is another Christ. We're expected to carry on his ministry in our day and age. That's why it is essential for us to know his frame of mind and understand how and why we are to suffer with him.

Our Christian sacred authors believed Jesus is alive today, sharing his love of all people through us. We're the ones who share his word

and love with the weary, who empty ourselves for the sake of others, and are willing to suffer in whatever ways are necessary to convey that love.

The city was ruled by Herod, puppet king under the Roman occupation, with the complicity of the temple establishment. Jesus' symbolic ride fulfilled the prophecy of Zechariah (9:9) and mocked the triumphal entrance of all conquering generals on white horses. His action was provocative in the extreme, and its symbolism would not have been missed by the authorities. Jesus had no power and far less prestige than any pope in modern times, and such a stunt was the first act in a drama that ended with his crucifixion.

Our Palm Sunday liturgy is only theater if it has no effect on our Christian commitment to follow Jesus in our own world, so marked by violent threats to anyone foolish enough to speak truth to power.


