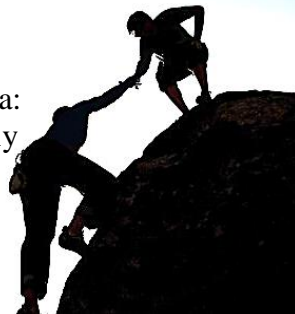
## THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

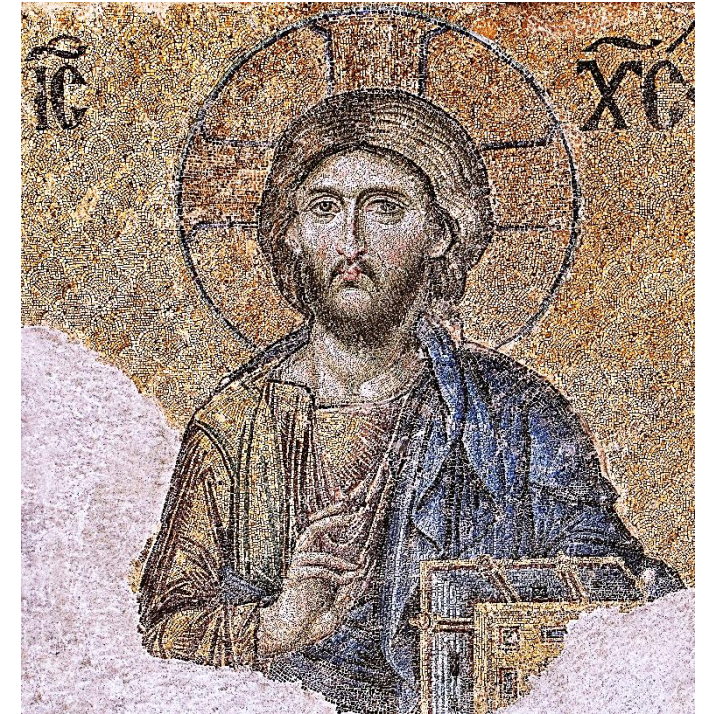
