**Canadian Jesuits International (CJI) Haiti Appeal**: to support the people after a magnitude 7.2 earthquake hit Haiti in August. The response will have two phases: emergency relief and recovery.

- In the **recovery phase**, Jesuit organizations will implement mid-to-long-term strategies focused on the reconstruction of homes and schools, and helping people rebuild their lives.
