St Ignatius Statement for the period March 21st to April 3rd: To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses you gave \$18,020. To SGG you gave \$1,345. For the Refugee Fund you gave \$845 (Ukrainian), \$645 (Afghan). You gave \$1,360 to D&P. To Easter and Good Friday collections you gave \$105.
