#### FINANCIAL REPORT

**Sharing God's Gifts Archdiocesan Collection (SGG):** Our assessment for 2021 is \$52,515, of which we still owe \$6,603. Thanks for supporting our Archdiocesan ministries.

**St Ignatius Statement for the period May 2<sup>nd</sup> to May 15<sup>th</sup>:** To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses you gave \$17,074. To SGG you gave \$1,137. For the Refugee Fund you gave \$850 (Ukrainian), \$600 (Afghan). You gave \$185 to D&P. To the Poor Box you gave \$39. Thank you for your generosity! (NB: For now, tallies are made every two weeks.)
