## FINANCIAL REPORT

**Sharing God's Gifts Archdiocesan Collection (SGG):** The balance of our 2021 assessment has been paid off. Our assessment for 2022 is \$65,582, of which we still owe \$65,287. Please make cheques payable to the Parish, earmarked "Sharing God's Gifts" – and print your name and envelope number clearly on the *Sharing God's Gifts* envelope. Thanks for supporting our Archdiocesan ministries.

**St Ignatius Statement for the period May 16<sup>th</sup> to May 29<sup>th</sup>:** To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses you gave \$19,406. To SGG you gave \$295. For the Refugee Fund you gave \$1,000 (Ukrainian), \$520 (Afghan). You gave \$150 to D&P. Thank you for your generosity! (NB: For now, tallies are made every two weeks.)

St Ignatius Parish and School are located on Treaty 1 territory – the traditional land and waters of the Ininiw (Cree), Anishinábé (Ojibwé), Anishiniw (Ojibwé Cree), Dakota, and Dene People, as well as the Birthplace of the Métis Nation and the Heart of the Métis Homeland. We also acknowledge the Shoal Lake #40 First Nation and its territory for our life-giving water, which allows us to live, work, and serve God in Winnipeg.

We are grateful for this land and the hospitality of these nations.
