## REFLECTION Outside Inside Out

You have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, 'You shall not murder;' and 'whoever murders shall be liable to judgement.'

But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgement; and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council; and if you say, 'You fool,' you will be liable to the hell of fire. (Matt 5: 21-22)
