
Wearing a mask is strongly recommended at all regular Masses.

REFLECTION

Walking the Way of Holiness

"...Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.

And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28: 20-21)

Matthew brings his Gospel to completion with Jesus' great commission. This passage tells us that there is Another who will tie us up and take us where we never imagined we could or would go (John 21: 18); there is a Power that is operative in us and accompanies us whether we know it or not and that will accomplish what we, by our own power, could never accomplish (Eph 3:20). To allow ourselves to be tied up and taken, to surrender to the greater authority, is to walk the most dramatic of the ways of holiness: coming to terms with the fact that our lives are not about us. When we do, we are then sent to do the work of Jesus.
