## FINANCIAL REPORT

**Sharing God's Gifts Archdiocesan Collection (SGG):** Our assessment for 2022 is \$65,582, of which we still owe \$16,504. Please make cheques payable to the Parish, earmarked "Sharing God's Gifts" – and print your name and envelope number clearly on the *Sharing God's Gifts* envelope. Thanks for supporting our Archdiocesan ministries.

**St Ignatius Statement for the period June 26<sup>th</sup> to July 2<sup>nd</sup>:** To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses, you gave \$8,079. For *Sharing God's Gifts* you gave \$1,690. For the Poor Box you gave \$46. For the Refugee Fund you gave \$100. Thank you for your generosity!

Contributions made through PAC and PayPal are monitored monthly. For the period June 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup>, PAC donations totaled \$16,354. PayPal donations during June totaled \$3,027.81.
