

REFLECTION

The Parable of the Sower (Matt 13)

We have a rare privilege in that Jesus himself gives a direct explanation of the meaning of this parable [of the sower]. It would be unwise in the extreme to venture down some other interpretive path. Keep in mind that Jesus himself in person is the seed sown. Jesus is the seed that wants to take root in us. This seed is sown far and wide, through all sorts of means. It is destined for the whole world....

[From Jesus' explanations of the four contingencies for the reception of the sown seed] we can construe the nature of good soil. When we understand the faith; when we take the time to read theology, to study the Scriptures, to feel with the Church; when we have perseverance; when we are disciplined and enter into the practice of the faith; when we have our priorities straight – then the seed will take root in us. And it will bear fruit thirty, sixty, or a hundredfold.

St Ignatius Statement for the period July 3rd to July 9th: To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses, you gave \$6,028. For *Sharing God's Gifts* you gave \$655. For the Poor Box you gave \$55. Thank you for your generosity!
