REFLECTION

Getting to the Roots of Our Sin

[Today's Gospel passage] highlights the repentance of a son who changed his mind and obeyed his father. This is the way of Jesus. He wants a total renovation of our lives. He wants us to get to the roots of our sin and dysfunction, addressing not just the symptoms but the deep causes.

Perhaps your relational life or sexual life are dysfunctional; Jesus wants to root out the problem, not just change the behavior. Perhaps your professional life has become tainted by sin; Jesus wants to cut to the roots of it, in your pride or your fear or your ambition. Perhaps there is a pattern of violence in your behavior; Christ wants to get to the envy or the greed that lies behind it. Change your heart and turn to God..

St Ignatius Statement for the period September 18th to September 24th: To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses, you gave \$4,519.
