



*Sharing God's Gifts* Archdiocesan Collection (SGG): Our assessment for 2023 is \$60,648, of which we still owe \$52,294. **St Ignatius Statement for the period December 11<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>:** To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses, you gave \$7,245. For *Sharing God's Gifts* you gave \$1,406. For Christmas, you gave \$286. For the Poor Box you gave \$46. Thank you for your generosity!
