Tip Tap

NEW Touchless/Cashless Payment Option

The parish has invested in a Tip Tap machine. It is located at the back of the church. This is a new payment option that churches all over the world are adopting.

How does it work? Simply use your credit card, apple pay, interact card, etc, and tap the amount you'd like to donate. **You can tap up to 10 times.**

Hold your card or phone up to the donation amount until you hear **1 beep**. Move your card or phone away and you will hear a second beep. This indicates the transaction has been approved. If you hear **3 beeps**, the transaction is declined.

If you want a tax receipt scan the **QR code** with your phone on the sign to request a tax receipt. You only need to sign up once per card used for a tax receipt. Tax receipts will be issued at the end of the year.
