## St. Ignatius Knights of Columbus 2024/25 Report



What a year! Our St. Ignatius Knights of Columbus Council 5808 continued to grow in 2024/25. We now have over 100 active members, including five men who joined at an exemplification ceremony in December 2024.

This year alone, the Knights raised nearly \$12,000 for St. Ignatius Parish through our well-attended annual Christmas and St. Patrick's Day fundraising dinners as well as the sale of grocery gift cards. These donations are helping the church pay its debt to the archdiocese through Sharing God's Gifts.



The Knights held four pancake breakfasts and hosted three movie nights over the last year. Proceeds from these great events supported the Missionaries of Charity (\$800), the Family Support Centre of Winnipeg crisis pregnancy centre (\$750), Villa Rosa crisis pregnancy housing (\$500) and Harvest Manitoba (\$500). We also provided \$500 to support Myles Cesario, a Winnipegger who is studying at St. Joseph's Seminary in Edmonton.



The Knights provided funding for two meals for the poor at Immaculate Conception Drop-In Centre and coordinated sandwich preparation by parishioners for two additional meals in May and June. During Advent, we raised \$1,100 and gathered several boxes of non-perishable food and gently used clothing to help typhoon victims in the Philippines.



The Knights continue to be incredibly active in our community, hosting Shrove Tuesday pancakes and participating in the Basketball Free Throw Competition with St. Ignatius School. We also host coffee and donuts after every Sunday Mass.

Thank you to all the Knights, their wives, and families who give so much back to our parish community. And thank you to Fr. Daryl Miranda, Fr. Joe Newman, and the many parishioners who support our work. Congratulations on another successful year!
