As vice president of the Ecclesial Conference of the Amazon (CEAMA), she works tirelessly alongside Indigenous communities—particularly in Rondônia—who face threats from illegal logging, land grabbing, and extractive industries. With her background in anthropology and specialization in social psychology, she brings both academic insight, lived experience, and a deep cultural understanding to her advocacy.
