Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Weekend of August 8/9, 2026

Today's Gospel reveals what miraculous things can happen when one embraces a single-minded faith in Jesus Christ. Peter gets out of a wind-tossed boat when the Lord calls him. His faith is tested by his obedience to Jesus who is calling him out onto the water. In the midst of the waves and the wind, Peter gets out of the boat and walks toward Jesus. Good stewards heed Christ's call to them. Sometimes that call directs them to take on seemingly impossible challenges. This week, reflect on how the Lord could be calling you out of the safety of your own "boat" to take on the impossible.



Information on *Together In Mission (TIM)*

The Archdiocese Annual Appeal called, ***Sharing God's Gifts*** (SGG) is being rebranded to ***Together in Mission*** (TIM) as of **September 1st**. There are some changes we want to bring to your attention at this time:

1. **Tax receipts** for donations you have made to Sharing God's Gifts appeal from January to August 2026 will be issued from St. Ignatius Parish in February.
2. The ***Together in Mission*** appeal begins, **September 1st**. Donations made from September 1st to December 31st to **TIM** will be tax receipted directly from the Archdiocese of Winnipeg.
3. Due to the re-branding of the program all currently set up pre-authorized donations for ***Sharing God's Gifts*** will be terminated as of August 31st. Parishioners who wish to participate in **TIM** will need to re-sign up either through the Archdiocese website or using the information cards provided from the Archdiocese (more information on this to come).
4. In prior years, the Parish would receive 100% of funds raised above our appeal target. Going forward, **the model has changed to an 80/20 split** whereby 80% of funds raised over the Together in Mission target come back to our Parish and 20% will support the wider mission of the Archdiocese.

Please note that you can continue using the **SGG envelopes you have for the rest of the year.** The new **TIM** envelopes will be in your new box, which you will receive at the end of the year. **You can continue to make out cheques to St Ignatius Church, as we will be processing the TIM donations and entering them into the new archdiocesan system.**

Those of you who have **PAC** for your **SGG**, we will give you more instructions soon. More information on Together in Mission will be shared in the coming weeks. In the meantime, if you have any immediate questions, feel free to discuss them with Fr. Daryl.
