'The Mystery of Vocation and the Consecrated Life' by Fr. James Hanvey SJ, available on the Dimensions Faith website.

The text offers a theological-spiritual meditation on the mystery of Christian vocation, with particular attention to the consecrated life, beginning with the liturgy of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. Through the biblical figures of Simeon and Anna, the reflection highlights vocation as encounter, expectation and openness to God's action in personal and community history. It also offers a glimpse of consecrated life as a prophetic sign and eschatological witness, rooted in the following of Christ and the mission of the Church, in dialogue with the challenges of the present time.
