## FINANCIAL REPORT

**Sharing God's Gifts Archdiocesan Collection (SGG):** Our assessment for 2023 is \$60,648, of which we still owe \$42,152. Thank you for supporting our Archdiocesan ministries.

**St Ignatius Statement for the period February 12<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>:** To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses, you gave \$4,198.

For *Sharing God's Gifts*, you gave \$ 1129. For the Poor Box you gave \$54. Thank you for your generosity!

Contributions made through PAC and PayPal are monitored monthly. For January 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup>, PAC donations totaled \$ 17,518 and PayPal donations totaled \$ 2,357.08.
