FINANCIAL REPORT

Sharing God's Gifts Archdiocesan Collection (SGG): Our assessment for 2023 is \$60,648, of which we still owe \$37,887. St Ignatius Statement for the period March 11th to 17th: To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses, you gave \$5,389.
