- At least sixteen years of age.
- Catholics who have been Confirmed and received the Holy Eucharist.
- Leading a life in harmony with the faith and be practicing Catholics;
- If married, be in a valid Catholic marriage;
- Not the father or mother of the one to be baptized;

The parents may choose one or two godparents. If they choose two, one should be male and the other female.

The Catholic Church allows (Can.874.2) a second baptized (non-Catholic) person to be admitted as witness to the baptism, along with a Catholic who serves as the primary sponsor/godparent.
