

## **CORONA VIRUS INFORMATION**

as of 2020-03-15

Based on advice from health experts, and in line with the intention of Archbishop Gagnon and directives from the Jesuit Provincial, our Parish is taking the following steps until further notice in order to minimize the spread of corona virus transmission:

- Holy Communion will be distributed under one species only (i.e., no Communion Cup will be shared);
- Communion will be given only in the hand; it will not be given on the tongue;
- Parishioners will share the "Sign of Peace" during Mass without physical contact. Please offer your neighbour only a smile, and a nod or bow.
- Holy water will not be available in the fonts.
- Parishioners will please cover occasional coughs and sneezes with the crook of the elbow.
- Parishioners will throw away used tissues in the waste baskets provided; never leave them in the pews or on the church floors.
- Parishioners are excused from attendance at Mass, and are asked to stay home if:
  - o they have any symptoms (coughs, fever, etc)
  - if they have returned in the last two weeks from travel outside Canada or to virus "hotspots" inside Canada.
