## FINANCIAL REPORT

**Sharing God's Gifts Archdiocesan Collection (SGG):** The balance of our 2021 assessment has been paid off. Our assessment for 2022 is \$65,582, of which we still owe \$64,215. Thanks for supporting our Archdiocesan ministries.

**St Ignatius Statement for the period May 30<sup>th</sup> to June 12<sup>th</sup>:** To our combined regular Sunday collections in support of our Parish, including school and church expenses you gave \$16,930. To SGG you gave \$1,072. For the Refugee Fund you gave \$50 (Ukrainian), \$50 (Afghan). You gave \$115 to D&P. To Agape and the Poor Box you gave \$86. Thank you for your generosity!
